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An Introduction to Our Services

St John's Hospice is a local charity. We have been supporting patients, families and the wider community in North Lancashire and the South Lakes since 1986. Serving a population of over 250,000 people, we are specialists in palliative care for a wide range of life shortening conditions.

Specialists in Palliative Care

Palliative care focuses on providing patients with relief from symptoms and end of life care. Having a life shortening condition does not mean that quality of daily life should suffer. Our experienced team of specialists work together with our patients to make sure they are getting the care and support they need to live their life the way they want to, as much as possible.

Our Support Team

As part of our holistic approach to palliative care, patients have the support of a wide range of experienced, professional staff as well as our wonderful team of volunteers, all dedicated to making sure patient needs are met.

In-Patient Unit

Our in-patient unit provides a high standard of specialist palliative care and support around the clock, 365 days of the year, for anyone aged 18 years and over.

Patients come to us for symptom management, treatment and end of life care. Our team of dedicated healthcare professionals are on hand to offer comfort, support and the highest standards of care.

Day Hospice at The Oak Centre

Our Day Hospice provides a place for people to come and talk to others going through similar experiences to them, make friends, take part in group exercises or perhaps relax with a complementary therapy session. The aim is to enhance quality of life and to promote independence as far as possible.

Day Hospice supports patients and families with a wide range of life shortening conditions. In addition to cancer there are some condition specific support sessions available.

Hospice at Home

Our Hospice at Home team is a dedicated unit of healthcare professionals who visit patients in the comfort of their own home to offer expert palliative care at the end of life. Offering symptom management, support and advice, the team are there to help both the patient and their family.

Working in partnership, the team work around the clock, 24 hours a day, 7 days a week offering first class care and giving extra comfort and support to patients and families when they need it most.

They also offer a night sitting service in some parts of the South Lakes; experienced healthcare assistants support patients through the night allowing family members to get much needed rest.

The team travel as far as Garstang in the south, Sedbergh in the east and Ambleside in the north meaning that their skills reach into all corners of our community, every single day of the year.
