FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

HOW DO I ENTER THE SUPERDRAW?

You can enter by buying tickets/entries. These will either have been sent to you or you might have seen an advert somewhere. They can be purchased at the Hospice, through our wonderful shops or by ringing the hotline 01524 382538. Each entry costs £1 and each person can buy up to 50 tickets. If you would like to buy more than 50 tickets, please call us on the number above.

WHAT IS THE LINK BETWEEN THE SUPERDRAW AND THE ST JOHN'S HOSPICE LOTTERY?

The Superdraw is a part of the weekly lottery. For one week only we have boosted the prize pot and allowed people to buy additional tickets. This means that current lottery players can buy extra tickets for this week and non-members can also buy one-off tickets for a chance to win the prizes on offer.

I ALREADY PLAY THE LOTTERY - CAN I TAKE PART IN THE SUPERDRAW?

Yes, absolutely! Your existing entries will automatically go in the Superdraw on 21st July and you are able to buy more that week if you like. You can buy them online or by ringing 01524 382538.

I ALREADY PLAY YOUR LOTTERY, BUT I DON'T WANT TO BUY ANY ADDITIONAL ENTRIES FOR THE SUPERDRAW, IS THIS OK?

Of course, you don't have to do anything different to normal and you'll still be in with a chance to win.

I'M NOT A MEMBER OF YOUR LOTTERY AT THE MOMENT - CAN I TAKE PART IN THE SUPERDRAW?

Yes, definitely! You can enter the Superdraw without needing to be a weekly lottery subscriber. Entries cost £1 each and you are eligible to win any of the prizes on offer.

I'VE REALLY LIKED BEING PART OF THE SUPERDRAW AND I'D LIKE TO JOIN THE LOTTERY. HOW CAN I DO THIS?

ARE MY ENTRIES ELIGIBLE FOR GIFT AID?

Unfortunately, as with any charity fundraising lottery, entries are not eligible for Gift Aid. We can however, claim Gift Aid on donations.

HOW DO I FIND OUT IF I HAVE WON?

All winners will be posted on our website and you can call into any of our charity shops, or contact the lottery office to find out if you are a winner. All physical ticket holders and people who bought their tickets online will have their prize cheques sent out automatically by post on the day of the draw. This is why it's really important that we have full contact details for you so there is no delay in getting your winning cheque to you. We'll also try and call the jackpot winner on the day to pass on the good news!

HOW DO I CLAIM A PRIZE?

If you have bought physical tickets, or bought your tickets online, there is no need for you to claim a prize. All winners will have their prize cheques sent out automatically by post on the day of the draw. This is why it's really important that we have full contact details for you so there is no delay in getting your winning cheque to you. If you bought your tickets in one of our shops, you can claim your prize by contacting St John's Hospice.

CAN YOU GUARANTEE THE SUPERDRAW IS FAIR?

Yes, every £1 entry has an equal chance of winning, and the winning numbers are drawn at random.

IS THE SUPERDRAW LEGAL?

Yes, we operate in compliance with all Gambling Commission (the UK regulatory body concerned with lotteries) requirements and UK Gambling law. For further information, please see our lottery rules page.

WHAT IS THE MINIMUM AGE REQUIREMENT TO ENTER?

You must be over the age of 16 to enter the Superdraw. We may ask you for your date of birth and relevant ID to prove that you are over 16 and therefore allowed to take part.

I'M UNCOMFORTABLE WITH THE FACT THAT ST JOHN'S HOSPICE RAISES MONEY THROUGH GAMBLING.

We realise that raising money this way is not for everyone, this is why the Superdraw and the St John's Lottery are entirely optional. However, money raised through our lottery provides really important and sustainable income for the hospice. Since it began in 2012, our lottery has raised more than £1 million, which has helped many local families when they have needed it most.
