

Great North Run 2024 Terms & Conditions

Terms & Conditions

- You agree to raise a minimum amount of £400 in sponsorship money and that this money will be donated to St John's Hospice.
- The sponsorship money must be paid in full to St John's by 25th October 2024 (no expenses can be offset against this).
- You agree to pay a registration fee of £35 to secure your place in the Great North Run and accept that this fee is non-refundable.
- You acknowledge that training for and participating in the Great North Run involves strenuous physical activity and risk of personal injury. You confirm that, to the best of your knowledge, you are suitably fit and healthy to take part in the event. You will be taking part in and completing the event at your own risk.
- A token will be issued to you from St John's Hospice by email and it is your responsibility to redeem
 this via the Great North Run event entry system. Only this action will fully secure your place.
 Although the Great North Run has a deadline date in July 2024 by which complete this action, we ask
 that you complete this registration by 1st May 2024 otherwise your place may be re-allocated to
 someone on our waiting list.
- By supplying your contact details, you are providing consent that St John's Hospice will contact you about **this event only** by email, post & phone.
- If for any reason you cannot take part, you must contact St. John's Hospice as soon as possible as your place is non-transferrable.
- You understand that photographs may be taken of you and others and may be used to publicise future events and the work of St John's Hospice.
- Due to the high cost of purchasing places for the Great North Run, the charity must ensure that all
 fees are covered. If you drop out after the final registration date, 1st July 2024, and cannot defer your
 place to 2025, you will be liable for £125 to cover the costs St John's Hospice have already incurred.

 running vest.
